

CITRUS GUIDE PLUS AVOCADO



Shasta Gold Mandarin
Seedless and very juicy. Seedless with dark orange flesh.
Fruit ripens: Winter -Spring



Minneola Tangelo
Red-orange, thin, easy peel rind. Sweet-tart, juicy flesh with few seeds.
Fruit ripens: Winter-Spring



Fingered Citron Buddhas' Hand
Fingerlike sections consist of rind only. Used for zest or candied rind.
Fruit ripens: Late Fall-Winter



Yuzu
A small, bumpy, yellow fruit . Tart, sour flavor and a strong scent, and it tastes like a combo of a lemon and a grapefruit.
Fruit ripens: Late Summer/Fall



Valentine Pummelo
Combination of Pummelo, a mandarin, and a blood orange. Fruit flesh resembles a heart when sliced in half.
Fruit ripens: Around Valentines day



Australian Finger Lime
Also called Citrus Caviar. Fruit contains vesicles bursting with lemon-lime flavor.
Semi-Everbearing



Red Finger Lime
Fruits have finger-like shape and many round, tart and juicy vesicles inside. The tree has thorny branches and small, rounded leaves.



Byron's Sunrise Finger Lime
Dark maroon skin and bright orange-red caviar-like pearls . The fruit is elongated and finger-like in shape.
Less tart than other varieties



Bacon (Type B)
8-12oz ovoid shaped fruit with green medium-thin skin. Medium sized upright tree. *Ripens: Fall -Winter*



Carmen Hass (Type A)
Similar to Hass Avocado, but grows smaller 6-14 oz. fruit. Has two distinct crops a year.
Ripens: Spring/Winter



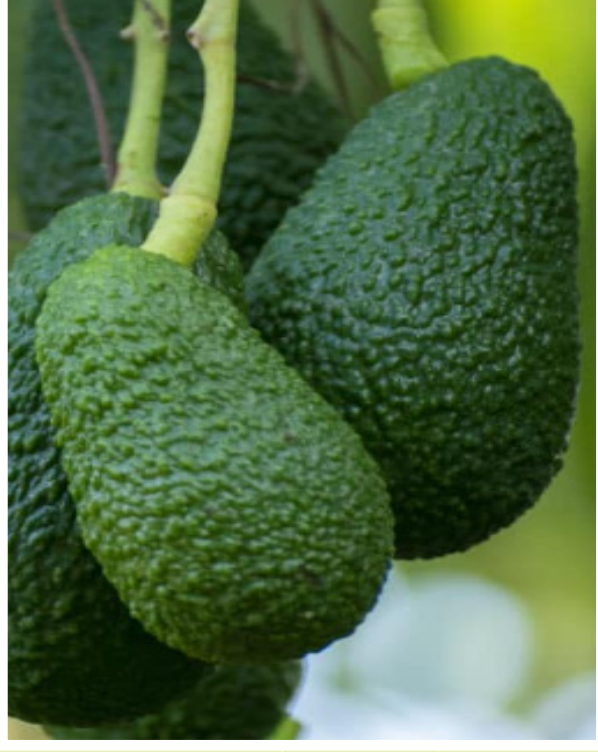
Fuerte Avocado (Type B)
9-16oz pear shaped fruit with green medium-thin skin. Large sized spreading tree.
Ripens: Winter-Spring



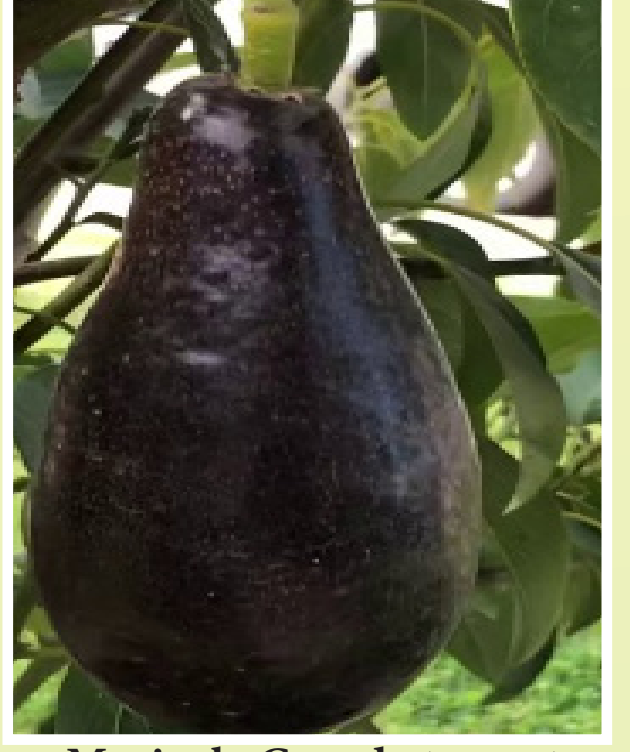
Gem (Type A)
7-11oz pear shaped fruit with green medium-thin skin. Upright compact sized tree.
Ripens: Spring



Gwen (Type A)
Fruit is similar to the Hass variety, but slightly larger. oval and plump with thick green skin with pebbled texture
Fruit ripens: Winter-Summer



Hass (Type A)
6-14oz pear shaped fruit with green/black medium-rough skin. Medium sized spreading tree. *Fruit ripens: Winter-Summer*



Mexicola Grande (Type A)
6-10oz round pear shaped fruit with black medium-thin skin. Large sized spreading tree. *Fruit ripens: Summer- Winter*



Pinkerton (Type A)
6-10oz round pear shaped fruit with black medium-thin skin. Large sized spreading tree.
Fruit ripens: Summer- Winter



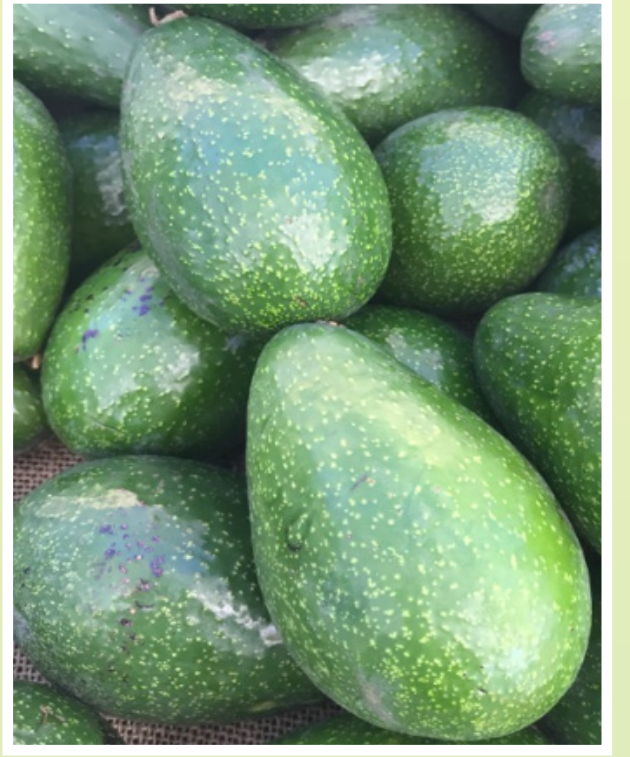
Queen (Type B)
Large, pear-shaped fruits that can weigh up to 30 ounces. Known for its excellent flavor and cold hardiness: *Ripens: Summer*



Reed (Type A)
12-18oz round shaped fruit with green medium-thick skin. Medium sized spreading tree.
Ripens: Fall-Winter



Sir Prize (Type B)
Large, with a small seed, buttery in texture, with a rich nutty flavor. Hass type avocado with black skin and 10-20 oz. fruit. *Ripens: Spring - Summer*



Zutano (Type B)
A cold-hardy variety of avocado that are known for their pear shape, thin skin, and mild flavor.
Ripens: Fall -Winter
